ITEM TITLE: ACTION ITEM: TETON CREEK BANK STABILIZATION BOULDER DONATION TO TETON CREEK FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT #18

SUMMARY STATEMENT:

Friends of the Teton River and the Teton Creek Flood Control District No. 18 have requested the donation of 300 cubic yards of boulders owned by Teton County for the Teton Creek Restoration project. The possibility was discussed at the 7/22 and 8/12 BoCC meetings. The Prosecuting Attorney agreed a donation to a non-profit could be done through an approved resolution. Attached is the resolution that would approve the County donating 300 cubic yards of boulders to be used for the next phase of the Teton Creek Restoration project.

FISCAL NOTES:

Boulders were purchased years ago by Teton County for \$23/cy. The donation would be equivalent to a \$6,900 donation to the Teton Creek Restoration Project.
